Warrant #44 dated 4/30/2021, in the amount of \$12,472.63

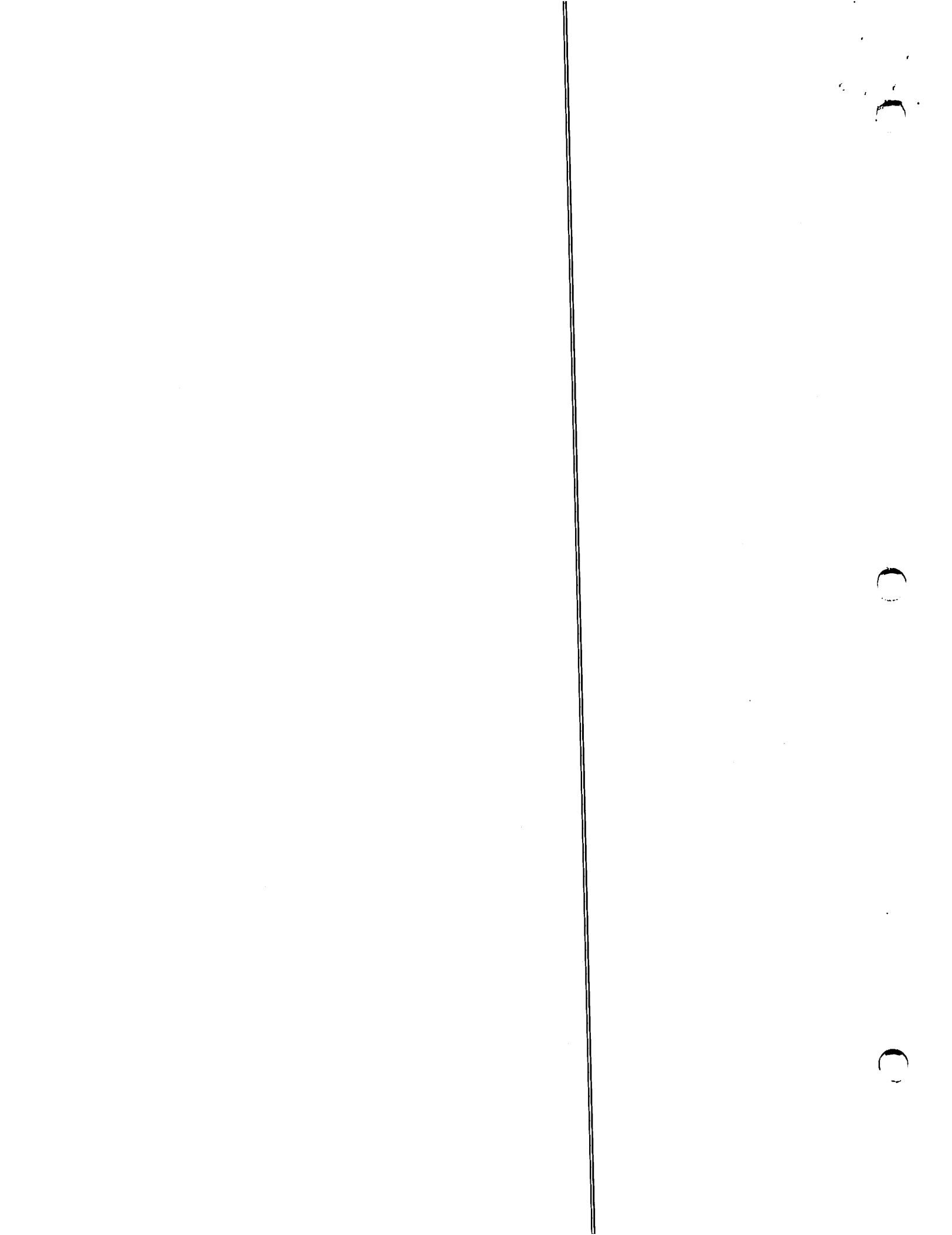
Warrant #45 dated 5/7/2021, in the amount of \$46,259.21
